[HOW TO PRAY FOR OTHERS]

L LISTEN • Listen to the prayer request.

E EYES OPEN • Pray with eyes open so you can observe visible signs of God at work.

A ASK • Ask for permission before laying hands on the person.

P PRAY • Start with a blessing, then pray for physical or emotional healing.

B BLESS • Bless the person again at the end of the prayer.

L LISTEN • Listen for how the person is feeling.

T TELL • Tell possible scenarios, if needed.

TO-GO Go out and pray for others.
