HOW TO DO ELECTRONIC CHECK-IN

Using electronic check-in on Sundays to get your name tag is quick and easy:

- 1) Register for a First Prez fob by the Hospitality table at the Sanctuary entrance. This fob is now assigned to you.
- 2) Go to a check-in station.
- 3) Face the barcode on the fob to the scanner on the desk. A beep will confirm the scanner read your barcode.
- 4) On the screen, select the worship service you're attending. A check mark will appear to confirm your entry.
- 5) Press the box labeled "Check-in" in the bottom right of the screen.
- 6) Your name tag will print from the lower part of the desk.
- 7) Tear off name tag UPWARD from the corner to avoid paper jams.

* Note: When you use electronic check-in, there's no need to fill out the Aloha form in the green folders.
