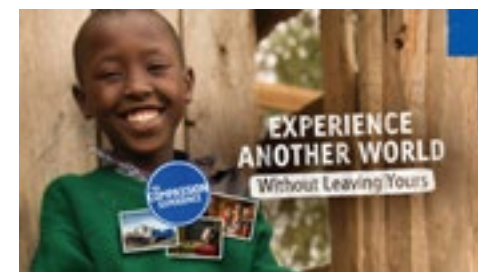
### MISSION TRIPS TO eSWATINI AND TANZANIA
