GIVE ALOHA

Sept 1-30, Foodland grocery stores

First Prez will participate in GIVE ALOHA, Foodland's annual gift-matching program for nonprofits. Between Sep 1-30, give your regular donations to First Prez through the check-out stations of Foodland, and they'll match a percentage of it, which makes your gift bigger.

Here's how to GIVE ALOHA:

- Go to any Foodland or Sack 'N Save grocery store any time this September.
- Let the cashier know you want to make a donation to First Prez through GIVE ALOHA.
- Cashier will ask for your Maika'i card, Foodland's frequent shopper card. If you don't have a Maika'i card, request for one from the cashier.
- You can donate more than once in Sept, but the total must not exceed \$249.
- Keep transaction receipt for tax purposes, as this will be your only record of your donation. First Prez will NOT be able to give you a receipt for your GIVE ALOHA donation.
