NEW SERMON SERIES: "TOGETHER" Apr 7-May 26, Sundays, 8AM and 10AM

We will continue our exploration of the Sermon on the Mount in an eight-week series called TOGETHER. It will help us explore challenging topics like how to constructively deal with our anger, how to seek reconciliation when something breaks in our relationships with others. The study will also touch on forgiveness, Jesus' view of marriage, the importance of keeping our word, and how we can learn to love like Jesus calls us to love.

Relationships are at the heart of all of our lives because we are created in the image of a relational God. It is astounding that the core reality at the center of the universe is a relationship: Father, Son, and Spirit. We are made for a relationship with God and with other people.


EXPERIENCING GOD THROUGH ART Apr 27, Sat, 5PM-8PM, The Vine
