INSTRUCTOR: TIM FEARER

How many questions did Jesus ask? How well did He listen and observe? And how did His listening and question-asking guide Him in this teaching? We'll explore leading by listening, observing and asking powerful open-ended questions, and then see all of the spiritual fruit which results.

During the pandemic, Jo found hand-lettering to be a great stress reliever. The creative process behind hand-lettering brings her both joy and calm.


WAKO 7:30 PM CLASSES
