Questions for Luke 1:26-38

1. Read Luke 1:38 "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May it be to me according to your word." Who do you know, currently or in the past, who models the characteristics of faith, trust, humility, and grace in life? How does he or she inspire you?
2. What does it mean that you are highly favored? Is this difficult to process or accept? Why or why not? What are some of the filters in your mind that have built up over the years? Read 1 Peter 2:9 and discuss this verse in light of the angel Gabriel's statement to Mary.
3. Do you believe that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28)?
 - Is this a verse you've heard only in the bad times of life?
 - How can we hold onto this verse "in all things" at all times?
 - Our stories are not yet finished, but can you look back at the circumstances of your life and see how God weaves all things together?
 Pray and ask God for revelation and guidance from Him.
4. In Ephesians, the apostle Paul wrote about the adoption theme, how God is a parent who chose us. We are not only His children, but heirs (Ephesians 1:11). How does it feel that we receive God's inheritance both here and in heaven? How does this knowledge impact the way we live our daily lives? Do you live with greater grace? Forgiveness for others? Joy?
5. Share prayer requests and pray with one another.
