Scripture: John 2:1-11

1. Is it ok to pray for a parking space? Is anything too trivial or mineenee to lift up to God? Why or why not?
2. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17. What does "pray without ceasing" mean to you?
3. Prayer is not a magical thing- It just means talking to your best friend about everything. What is your relationship with Jesus like? Can you talk about everything with Him, or do you have barriers, even distance from your relationship with Christ?
4. Mary says to the servants, "Do whatever Jesus tells you to do". Are we willing to do whatever Jesus tells us to do? Do you try to bring Jesus into all situations for the sake of others?
 - If Jesus tells you to pray for someone are you immediately doing intercessory prayer?
 - If He tells you to be generous and give something to someone are you?
 - Are we putting our own physical effort in helping someone showing some Grit....and Grace?
5. Do we do things on our own strength, or do we rely on the power of the Holy Spirit? Examine your actions and behavior in the last week- do you first rely on earthly secular thinking? Do you want to be filled more with the power of the Holy Spirit? In your group, pray for one another- to be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit.
6. Life with God is a relationship. The power of the Holy Spirit is not something to be attained like an asset or product. How do you continue to grow in your relationship with God? How are you experiencing His presence daily?
